# LVHN COVID-19 TESTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR LAFAYETTE FACULTY AND STAFF

Lafayette College has partnered with Lehigh Valley Health Network (LVHN) to provide COVID-19 testing for faculty and staff as part of the college's return to campus safety plans. As part of this partnership, LVHN is providing the following services:

- A designated testing location convenient to campus in Bethlehem Township.
   See below for location and directions.
- Easy access to results through MyLVHN app. Any patient with a positive test will be contacted by phone. Both positive and negative test results can be easily accessed through MyLVHN. Instructions for signing up for MyLVHN are below.
- LVHN-Lafayette Nurse Line with support for faculty and staff signing up for MyLVHN or any issues accessing results.

# **Testing Instructions and Location**

1. Bring your order for testing from Bailey Health Center, your insurance card, and photo ID to the following location:

- 2. After being registered, a clinician will administer a nasopharyngeal (NP) test.
- 3. Don't forget to wear your mask!
- 4. Testing turnaround times are generally 2 days but may vary based on testing volume. If you do not have a result within 3-4 days, call the LVHN-Lafayette Nurse Line (next page).

### How to Enroll in MyLVHN

All Lafayette faculty and staff are encouraged to sign up for a MyLVHN account if you have not already done so. It is an easy process and in the event you need to access care quickly an activated MyLVHN account will streamline the process. To enroll, follow these steps:

### With an activation code (received at the test site)

- Go to MyLVHN.org or download MyLVHN app.
- Select "Sign up Now" button.
- Complete the online form. You will need your personal activation code and last four digits of your social security number.

### Without an activation code

- Visit MyLVHN.org or download MyLVHN app.
- Select "Sign up Now" button.
- Select "Sign up Online" to complete the online form. You will need to provide your social security number. If available, include your LVHN medical record number.
