

You Have Tested **positive** for COVID-19

You are receiving this email because you have tested positive for Covid-19. You can help stop the spread of COVID-19 to others. Please follow the guidelines below.

Symptoms:

Many individuals do not exhibit symptoms. Common symptoms include fever, cough, and shortness of breath. Other symptoms may include chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, and new loss of taste or smell.

Contact Tracing:

You will be contacted by the Pa. Dept. of Health and an individual from the college with training in contact tracing will also call you. You will be contacted daily by a nurse from the Bailey Health Center as well, to monitor any symptoms.

You will be moved to a designated housing unit for Isolation:

- if your Covid test is positive and you remain asymptomatic, 10 days of isolation is required.
- If your covid test is positive and you have symptoms, isolation is required for 10 days AND 24 hours of no fever (without fever reducing medication) AND improvement of symptoms.
- Meals will be delivered to you while in Isolation
